

## Modern Slavery: National Referral Mechanism Statistics October - December 2015

### **Key points**

- During the period October to December 2015 there were 939 referrals to the National Referral Mechanism (NRM), comprising individuals from 65 countries of origin.
- As at 17/03/2016, 136 of the 939 people referred to the NRM during this quarter received a positive conclusive decision and were therefore found to have been trafficked.
- 37 of the 939 people referred to the NRM were still awaiting a reasonable grounds decision. 493 of the 939 people referred were still awaiting a conclusive decision.
- 13 people were referred from Northern Ireland, 45 from Scotland and 45 from Wales. The remaining 836 were referred in England.

# National Referral Mechanism Statistics - October - December 2015

This report has been primarily provided to inform the Home Office Modern Slavery Unit of the UK's delivery against a number of definitive requirements contained in the Council of Europe Convention on Action against Trafficking in Human Beings. Reports are produced for each quarter; the previous report (0280-UKHTC) included statistics from July to September 2015 and was published in April 2016.

It is important to note that the number of referrals outlined in this report is not a measure of modern slavery in the UK; rather it indicates the number of individuals who have been referred in to the system as potential victims of modern slavery or human trafficking.

### Data base

The information in this report is obtained from referrals made to the National Referral Mechanism (NRM) for the three month period from October to December 2015. The data used is correct as at 17/03/2016. It should be noted that the data used is a 'snapshot in time' and there are decisions on trafficking status yet to be made.

The data cut-off date for this report is 17/03/2016.

### Introduction

- 1. On 01/04/2009 the UK adopted a National Referral Mechanism (NRM), which is a process to identify individuals who may be potential victims of trafficking (PVoT) and provide them with the protection and support to which they are entitled under the Council of Europe Convention on Action against Trafficking in Human Beings.
- 2. The process starts when a designated 'first responder' refers a potential victim to one of two separate, but linked, UK Competent Authorities: the Home Office UK Visas and Immigration Department and the National Crime Agency UK Human Trafficking Centre. The process has two stages, 'Reasonable Grounds' and 'Conclusive Decision', during which trained staff assess all available information in reaching a decision as to whether or not the individual is a victim of modern slavery.

### **Changes to the NRM Process**

- 3. Modern slavery is a term that covers slavery, servitude, forced or compulsory labour and human trafficking. From 31 July 2015, in England and Wales, potential victims of slavery, servitude, forced or compulsory labour recognised with a positive reasonable grounds decision may also have access to support previously only offered to potential victims of human trafficking. In Scotland and Northern Ireland this support is currently only available to victims of human trafficking, and the NRM process is not considered for victims of slavery, servitude, forced or compulsory labour.
- 4. From 1 November 2015 the Home Office is piloting a new process for identifying and assessing potential victims of modern slavery entering the National Referral Mechanism:
- 5. In West Yorkshire police force area and the South West (Avon and Somerset, Devon and Cornwall, Dorset, Gloucestershire, and Wiltshire police force areas), NRM forms can be completed by any frontline worker and then referred to a local Slavery and Safeguarding Lead (SSL) for the reasonable grounds decision and entry to the NRM (where that decision is positive). In the rest of England and Wales only designated first responders can refer cases into the NRM.
- 6. This report contains data derived wholly from information supplied by the NRM. The data only reflects potential victims referred into the NRM and cannot be taken as a definitive situation report on modern slavery into, within or out of the UK. Potential victims may not be referred to the NRM for a number of reasons and therefore would not feature within this report.

The test that is applied is whether the statement 'I suspect but cannot prove...' would be true and whether a reasonable person would be of the opinion that, having regard to the information available, there were reasonable grounds to believe the individual concerned had been trafficked.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> The Competent Authorities have a target date of 45 calendar days from the reasonable grounds decision to make a conclusive decision on the individual's victim status having gathered further information. The test that is applied is whether on the balance of probabilities 'It is more likely than not...' that the individual was trafficked based on the information available.

7. Details for referrals from referring agencies<sup>4</sup> for the UK are contained in the tables after each summary of adult and minor referrals in the main text. Details for referrals from referring agencies in England are contained in Annex D; the 836 referrals represent 89% of the total UK referrals. Northern Ireland is contained in Annex E; the 13 referrals represent 1% of the total UK referrals. Details for referrals from referring agencies in Scotland are contained in Annex F; the 45 referrals represent 5% of the total UK referrals. Details for referrals from referring agencies in Wales are contained in Annex G; the 45 referrals represent 5% of the total UK referrals.

# Breakdown of All (Adult and Minor)<sup>5</sup> Referrals by Country of Origin, by Reasonable Grounds (RG) Decision and Conclusive Decision (CD)

- 8. During the three month period October to December 2015, there were 939 referrals of adults and minors to the NRM. These referrals comprise individuals from 65 countries of origin. The table below shows the 10 most frequently referred countries of origin, which account for 679 (72%) of all referrals<sup>6</sup>.
- 9. As at 17/03/2016, the most common countries of origin for people referred were Albania (184), Vietnam (174), Romania (68), Nigeria (65), and United Kingdom (44).
- 10. The most common countries of origin for people referred during this period who received a positive reasonable grounds decision and were therefore submitted to the conclusive decision process were Albania (159), Vietnam (128), Nigeria (51), Romania (40), and United Kingdom (40).
- 11. 136 (14%) of the 939 people referred to the NRM during this period received a positive conclusive decision and were therefore found to have been trafficked. The most common countries of origin for people who received a positive conclusive decision were United Kingdom (31), Romania (26), Poland (19), and Czech Republic (9).
- 12. 37 (4%) of the 939 people referred to the NRM during this period are still awaiting a reasonable grounds decision. The most common countries of origin for people who had not received a reasonable grounds decision were Vietnam (9), Albania (8), and Ethiopia (3).
- 13. 493 (53%) of the 939 people referred to the NRM during this period are yet to receive a conclusive decision. The most common countries of origin for people who had not received a conclusive decision were Albania (142), Vietnam (94), Nigeria (49), China (32) and Eritrea (20).

### Breakdown of Adults by Country of Origin, by Reasonable Grounds (RG) Decision and Conclusive Decision (CD)

- 14. There were 612 adult referrals to the NRM during this period, comprising individuals from 61 countries of origin. The table below shows the 10 most referred countries of origin, which account for 434 (71%) of all adult referrals $^{7}$ .
- 15. The most common countries of origin for adults referred this quarter were Albania (110), Vietnam (71), Romania (63), Nigeria (55) and China (32).
- 16. 489 (80%) of the 612 adult referrals received a positive reasonable grounds decision and were therefore submitted to the conclusive grounds process. The most common countries of origin were Albania (100), Vietnam (52), Nigeria (45), Romania (37) and China (29).
- 17. 101 (17%) of the 612 adult referrals received a positive conclusive decision and were therefore found to have been trafficked. The most common countries of origin for adults who obtained a positive conclusive decision were Romania (26), Poland (19), United Kingdom (9), Slovakia (8) and Bulgaria (7).

### Breakdown of Adult Referrals by Exploitation Type and Gender, by Reasonable Grounds (RG) Decision and Conclusive Decision (CD)

- 18. The breakdown of exploitation types for the 612 adults who were referred this period were labour exploitation 268 (44%), sexual exploitation 225 (37%) and domestic servitude 82 (13%). One referral was received claiming organ harvest (<1%). The type of exploitation was unknown for 36 (6%) of adults referred. Of these 612, 341 (56%) were female, 270 (44%) were male and 1 further case is recorded as transsexual (<1%).
- 19. Labour exploitation (200) and sexual exploitation (200) were the most common exploitation type for adults referred during this period who received a positive reasonable grounds decision and were therefore submitted to the conclusive grounds process. Labour exploitation (78) was the most common type for adults who received a positive conclusive decision and were therefore found to have been trafficked.

### Breakdown of Adult Referrals by Exploitation Type and Age Range, by Reasonable Grounds (RG) Decision and Conclusive Decision (CD)

- 20. Of the 612 adults referred, the largest age group represented were 21-30 year olds who comprised 261 (43%) of all adults referred this period. The 21-30 and 31-40 age groups were the most prevalent for adults who received a positive conclusive decision (31 in each category).
- 21. The age group 21-30 was the most prevalent across all exploitation types; labour and sexual exploitation and domestic servitude.

### Breakdown of Minors by Country of Origin, by Reasonable Grounds (RG) Decision and Conclusive Decision (CD)

- 22. 327 minors were referred to the NRM this quarter, comprising individuals from 32 countries of origin. The table below shows the 11 most frequently referred countries of origin, which account for 277 (85%) of all child referrals<sup>10</sup>.
- 23. The most common countries of origin for referred minors were Vietnam (103), Albania (74), United Kingdom (29), Eritrea (13) and Afghanistan (12).
- 24. 232 (71%) of the 327 minor referrals received a positive reasonable grounds decision and were therefore submitted to the conclusive decision process. The most common countries of origin were Vietnam (76), Albania (59), United Kingdom (27) and Eritrea (11).
- 25. 35 (11%) of the 327 minors referred to the NRM this period received a positive conclusive decision and were therefore found to have been trafficked. The most common countries of origin for minors who obtained a positive conclusive decision were United Kingdom (22), Czech Republic (3) and Eritrea, Ethiopia and Sudan (each with 2).

### Breakdown of Minor Referrals by Exploitation Type and Gender, by Reasonable Grounds (RG) Decision and Conclusive Decision (CD)

- 26. The exploitation types for the 327 minors who were referred were labour exploitation (114), sexual exploitation (47), domestic servitude (19) and one referral for organ harvesting. The exploitation type for 146 was unknown<sup>11</sup>. Of these 327 minors, 235 (72%) were males and 90 (28%) were females. The gender was not recorded for 2 further cases (<1%).
- 27. The most common exploitation type, where known, for minors who received a positive reasonable grounds decision and were therefore submitted to the conclusive decision process was labour exploitation (99).
- 28. The most common exploitation type for minors who received a positive conclusive decision and were therefore found to have been trafficked was sexual exploitation (24), accounting for 69% of the 35 minors receiving a positive conclusive decision.
